Program

Day 1: Arrival, Pompeii & Sorrento

Arrival at the airport of Naples, meeting with your local guide and transfer Sorrento. On the way stop to visit one of the most sacred and fascinating Roman sights – Pompeii. Well preserved by the ash and lava which destroyed the town in 79AD at the eruption of Mount Vesuvius, this is the ideal place for history lovers. Onwards to Sorrento, check in Accommodation, dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 2: Sorrento and its surroundings

After breakfast, guided tour of Sorrento and its beautiful surroundings, discovering the spectacular landscapes that this coastline offers and visiting the most important places of the city. Lunch in a local farm where you will see how mozzarella cheese is made, taste the local olive oil along with other local products. In the afternoon, visit to a gelato shop and a local limoncello maker with demos and tastings. Free time for shopping. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 3: The Vatican

Early breakfast in Hotel and departure for Rome, on arrival meeting your local guide and visit of the Vatican with its museums. Rome's landscape is instantly recognizable by the dome of St. Peter's Basilica, and no visit to the Eternal City would be complete without spending some time at the Vatican, the world's smallest independent state. They contain some of the world's greatest art pieces – most notably Michelangelo's frescoes on the Sistine Chapel ceiling. Rest of the afternoon @ your leisure. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 4: Ancient and Baroque Rome

Breakfast in hotel, meeting your local guide and departure for the visit of Rome. In the morning, the ancient part will be visited with, the famous Coliseum, originally known as the Flavian Amphitheatre, is arguably Rome's most iconic landmark; the forums, once at the very heart of this ancient city, and today represents the location of many of Rome's best-preserved monuments; Piazza Venezia etc... After the Baroque part of city will be visited with, Fontana di Trevi, one of the most impressive sites in Rome; The Spanish steps, known around the world for their majesty and beauty, linking two of Rome's most important attractions – the Piazza di Spagna and the Trinita dei Monti church; Piazza del Popolo and Piazza Navona. Free time for lunch during the excursion. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 5: Departure

At the appropriate time a private car/van or coach will return us to the airport to take our return flight home after a very varied tour.
